2010 US Youth Soccer Rhode Island Championships
Team Instructions



Entry Requirements:

Each team must submit a completed 2010 US Youth Soccer Rhode Island Championships Entry Form, team roster/game line-up form, signed Coach & Team Manager Agreement and the entry fee by check payable to SRI:

SRI Member Association Teams the Entry Fee is \$500.00

Non-SRI Member Association Teams the Entry Fee is \$750.00

All forms and payment must be received in the SRI office by 5:00 p.m. on February 19, 2010

Each team MUST send a representative to the US Youth Soccer Rhode Island Championships Draw, March 8, 2010, 7:00 p.m. at the Crowne Plaza Hotel, Warwick RI.

Rosters:

Each SRI team must submit a Youth Leagues USA Soccer-RI Championships roster to the SRI office. Non-SRI Teams must submit a state or league certified roster and/or game line-up form to the SRI office. The SRI office will email the roster and game line-up form stamped "2010 Soccer Rhode Island Championships – Frozen Roster" to each team manager, once an age group's rosters are frozen. Each team must make two (2) copies of the stamped and certified State Cup Game line-up form for each game of the competition.

Roster Freeze dates.

The rosters for the U12 through U17 age divisions will be frozen as of 8:00 pm on Monday, April 12, 2010 UNLESS a preliminary game is scheduled before 8:00 PM on April 12, 2010 then the rosters for ALL teams in that age group freeze at the close of business (posted SRI office hours) the day before the scheduled game.

The rosters for the U18 and U19 age divisions will be frozen as of 5:00 pm on Wednesday, June 2, 2010, UNLESS a preliminary game is scheduled before 5:00 PM on June 2, 2010 then the rosters for ALL teams in that age group freeze at the close of business (posted SRI office hours) the day before the scheduled game.

Maximum Roster

U12 8v8 has a max of 14 players on the roster

U12 11v11 through U16 has a max of 18 players on the roster.

U17 through U19 age groups are allowed a max of 22 players on their rosters. At one hour (60 minutes) prior to the posted game time, each team playing must submit a game line-up form with a max of 18 players to the State Administrator (or her designee) at the headquarters area. If a team does not submit a 18-player game line-up form to the State Administrator at least one hour (60 minutes) prior to the posted game time a team fine of \$750 shall be imposed unless the State US Youth Soccer Rhode Island Championships committee finds that extenuating circumstances occurred. Only players listed on the 18-player game line-up form may wear their uniforms at the venue. Team members not on the 18-player game line-up form may attend the game on the spectators' side of the field. These team members may not wear their uniform jersey, alternate uniform jersey or uniform shorts.

NEW RULE – for 2010 instituted by US Youth Soccer

A team may have on its team roster only players of the following age groups for the seasonal year in which the team is participating in the National Championships:

(1) For teams competing in the Under 14 and Under 15 age groups, each player on the team must be

(A) of the age of the age group competition in which the team is participating in that seasonal year,
or

(B) of the age in either of the next 2 younger age groups of that age group competition in which the team is participating in that seasonal year.

(2) For the teams competing in the Under 16, Under 17, Under 18, and Under 19 age groups, each player on the team must be:

(A) of the age of the age group competition in which the team is participating in that seasonal year,
Or

(B) of the age of any younger age group, through the Under 14 age group, of that age group competition in which the team is participating in that seasonal year.

SRI WILL ASSIGN THE REFEREES FOR ALL US YOUTH SOCCER RHODE ISLAND CHAMPIONSHIP GAMES

Preliminary Games:

A minimum of 72 hours prior to the start of the each preliminary game, both teams are to email the following information to Paul Hoxsie, pgh196@aol.com; Association name, age division, boys/girls date of game, time, location, and opposing association name.

The home team will be responsible to give the Referee Game Form (posted on the SRI website, State Cup page) to the Referee before the start of preliminary games

Each team will give the referee and opposing coach a copy of their stamped State certified RI Championships Frozen Roster/game line up form.

Each team is responsible for one-half of the referee fees for all preliminary games

Both teams should initial the game report upon completion of the game.

At the completion of the preliminary game both teams must email the score of the game to Paul Hoxsie, pgh196@aol.com by 10 PM the evening the game is played.
