



**6115 Commitment of Club Associations and their Coaches:** It is expressly understood by all Clubs, Associations, their administrators, referees, and coaches that no practices or games are to be scheduled on Olympic Development Training Dates. This includes all Wednesday evening training dates (April through July) and any mini-camps scheduled and published by March 1<sup>st</sup> on the Website ([www.soccer-ri.com](http://www.soccer-ri.com)).

**6116 Commitment of Players Selected:** It is expressly understood by all players and their parents/guardians that once selected to the program they are responsible for all fees associated with the program. No refunds will be given once accepted to the program should a player elect not to participate. It is further understood that players are expected to participate in all training sessions and designated Olympic Development Events including but not limited to tournaments, scrimmages, College Night, and any fundraising activities. Players may only be relieved of their obligations with the permission of the Vice President of the Olympic Development Program

**6117 Violation of Rule 6115:** Club/Association President and violating coach will be called to next board meeting to explain their/his/her reasons for not supporting the program and policy. The board will have the right to refer the matter to the State Disciplinary Board for review and sanctioning.

**6118 Violation of Rule 6116** The Vice President of the Olympic Development Program may with the permission of the SRI Board of Directors suspended a player or place a player in "bad standing" pending a hearing with the State Disciplinary Board.
